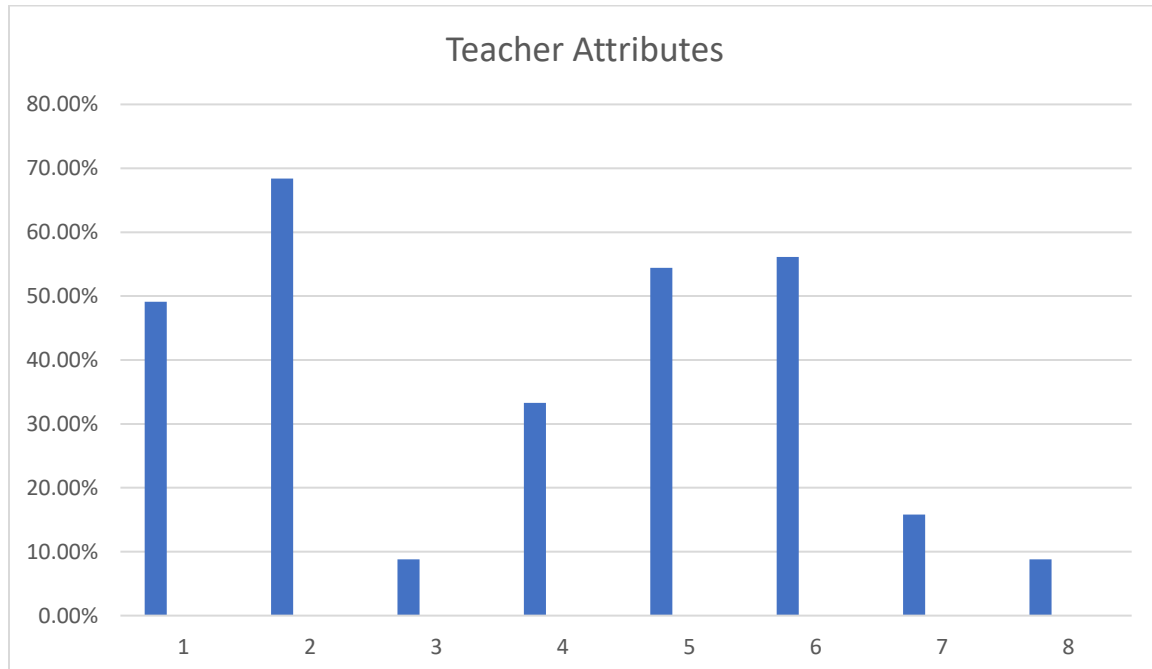


Stakeholder Survey Responses
